As the body of Christ, a living faith, we call each other:


Refreshed at the font, fed at the table, bathed in your Word, renewed in prayer,





MUSIC IN WORSHIP

Psalm 116 is a prayer of thanksgiving for God's goodness and healing - "you have loosed my bonds; you have set me free." The psalm concludes with the psalmist promising to be the Lord's servant, thereby fulfilling the vow to call on the Lord for a lifetime: "To the Lord I will pay my vows before all the people.

I will pay my vow to the Lord in the courts of God." This psalm is sung or recited each year at Passover time in Jewish homes to this day. It is part of the collection of psalms running from 113 – 118, centering on the story of the exodus from Egypt.

The hymn after the sermon, No. 297 "In Christ Called to Baptize," was written in 1995 by Ruth Duck for a former Notre Dame classmate in charge of planning worship for a Lutheran conference in Hong Kong. Despite the title, the hymn is not only about baptism, but about the church's ministry of word and sacrament and its mission in the world. The tune, ST. DENIO, is a Welsh folk tune.
